Nominations

Nominations for the above positions open on **Friday 19 July 2019** and must be made on the appropriate nomination paper for each position, available from the relevant electoral officer. Completed nomination papers must be received by the relevant electoral officer no later than **12 noon on Friday 16 August 2019**. Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 incl GST, payable by eftpos, cash or on-line banking (see candidate handbook for requirements).

Candidates are encouraged to submit a candidate profile statement and recent colour photograph for sending out with voting documents to electors. The requirements for profile statements and photos are set out in a candidate handbook which is available with the nomination papers.

Southern District Health Board candidates **must** also submit a conflict of interest statement with their nominations. Requirements for the conflict of interest statement are included in the DHB candidate handbook.

All nomination material must be lodged together. Candidates should refer to the respective candidate handbook for further details.
