Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 including GST, payable by eftpos, cash, bank deposit, internet banking or cheque. Candidates may submit a candidate profile statement and recent photograph for sending out with voting documents to electors. The requirements for profile statements and photos are set out in a candidate handbook which is available with the nomination papers.
