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MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT

This memorandum responds to the Court's directions regarding various matters to be considered at the resumed hearing on 29 May 2023 regarding policy 30, rule 78 and Appendix N of the proposed Southland Land and Water Regional Plan (pSWLP).

Questions for Ms McArthur

2. Counsel advises that there are no questions for Ms McArthur on behalf of Ngā Rūnanga.

Policy 30

3. Ngā Rūnanga advises that it supports the Court's wording of Policy 30 set out in the 6th Interim Decision, including the Court's suggested changes to the heading of the policy to refer to watercourses rather than drains.

Rule 78

- With respect to Rule 78, Ngā Rūnanga support the Rule set out in Appendix 2 of the Joint Witness Statement - Planning dated 23 May 2023. This version of the rule addresses the substance of the relief sought by Ngā Rūnanga in its appeal.
- Ngā Rūnanga support the strengthening of Rule 78 through the inclusion of additional clauses, as set out at paragraph [255] of the Court's Sixth Interim Decision.
- 6. If the Court considers there is scope to further strengthen Rule 78, Ngā Rūnanga would support the requirement to implement best-practice requirements through Farm Environmental Management Plans or a management plan approach for watercourses managed by a public entity, as set out in Joint Witness Statement Planning dated 23 May 2023, at paragraph [5].

7. For completeness, Ngā Rūnanga does not support the permitted activity rule advanced on behalf of Federated Farmers at Appendix 1 of the Joint Witness Statement - Planning dated 23 May 2023.
