1. The Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated (“Forest & Bird”) wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:

ENV-2015-AKL-029 Aratiatia Livestock Ltd v Southland Regional Council
2. Forest & Bird made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings.
3. Forest & Bird is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
4. Forest & Bird is interested in all of the proceedings except Objective 10.
5. Forest & Bird supports the relief sought in relation to Policy 26 and Rule 52A. Forest & Bird otherwise opposes the relief sought because it is not satisfied that the changes will result in maintenance or enhancement of water quality. In particular, it opposes the change sought to Rule 20 because the removal of limitations on mob size for cattle or deer are likely to result in poorer water quality outcomes.
6. Forest & Bird agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
