Under Section 62(3) of the Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Act 2011, if an activity is set to take place in an area subject to a pending Customary Marine Title application, the applicant is obligated to notify and seek the views from the group that has submitted the Customary Marine Title request, before submitting their resource consent application. Documentation proving such consultation must accompany your resource consent application, as required by Section 88(7) of the Resource Management Act 1991.

All applicants for coastal permits in the Southland Region must seek the views of Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu, the Customary Marine Title applicant for the coastal marine area and include a summation of those views in the application.

- You must seek the views of Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu before you lodge your application with Environment Southland.
- Please email maca@ngaitahu.iwi.nz, to request their view on your application. For example:
"Please find attached my application to replace my white bait stand consent ..., which I plan to submit to Environment Southland. I am requesting your views on the application as a Customary Marine Title applicant group. Please contact me if you have any questions." If you have additional questions you can contact or write to Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu, PO Box 13046, Christchurch 8141.

Their views should be recorded and attached to your application.

Environment Southland must return applications as incomplete if they do not include evidence of notification and the seeking of views with all relevant applicants.

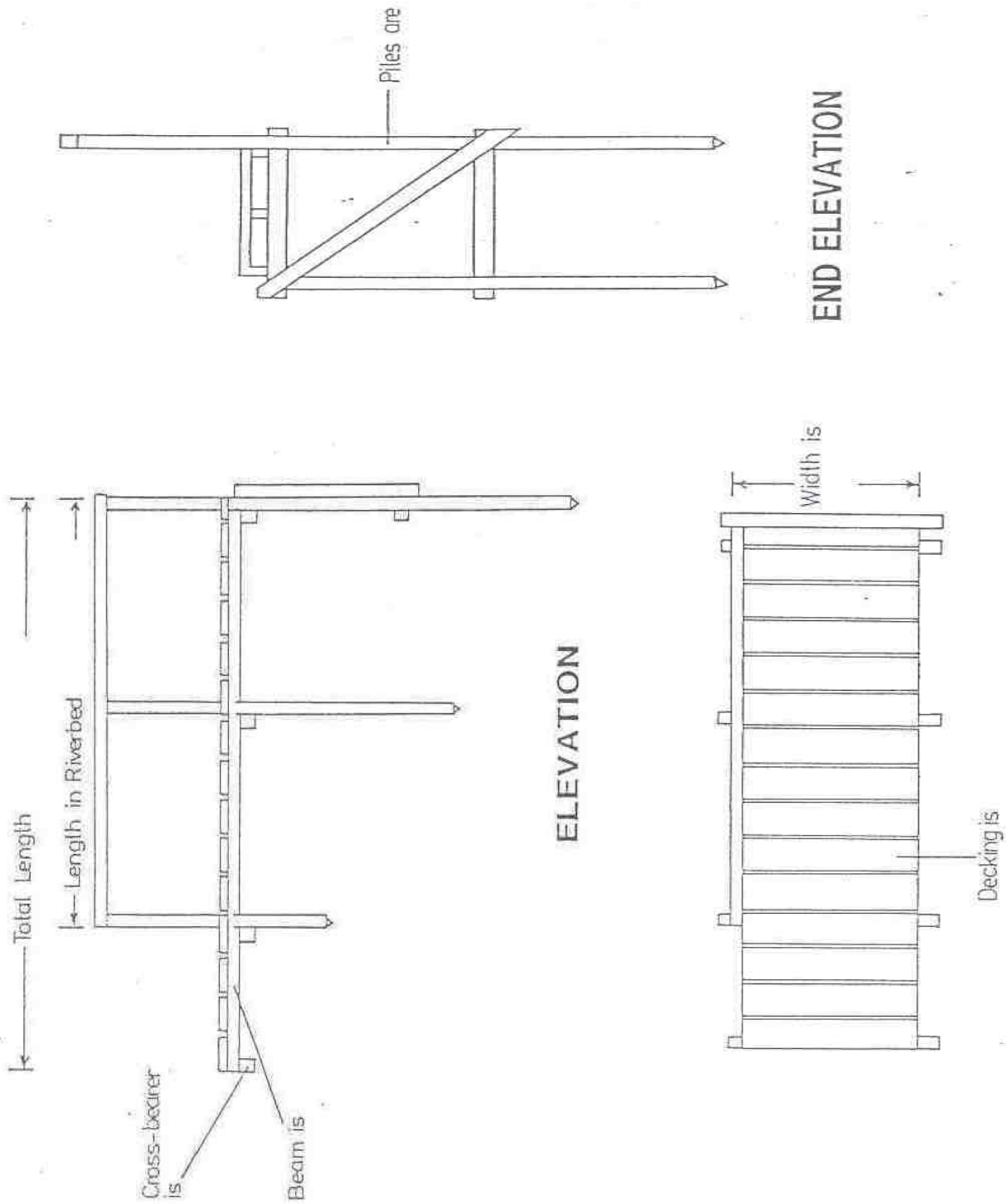
