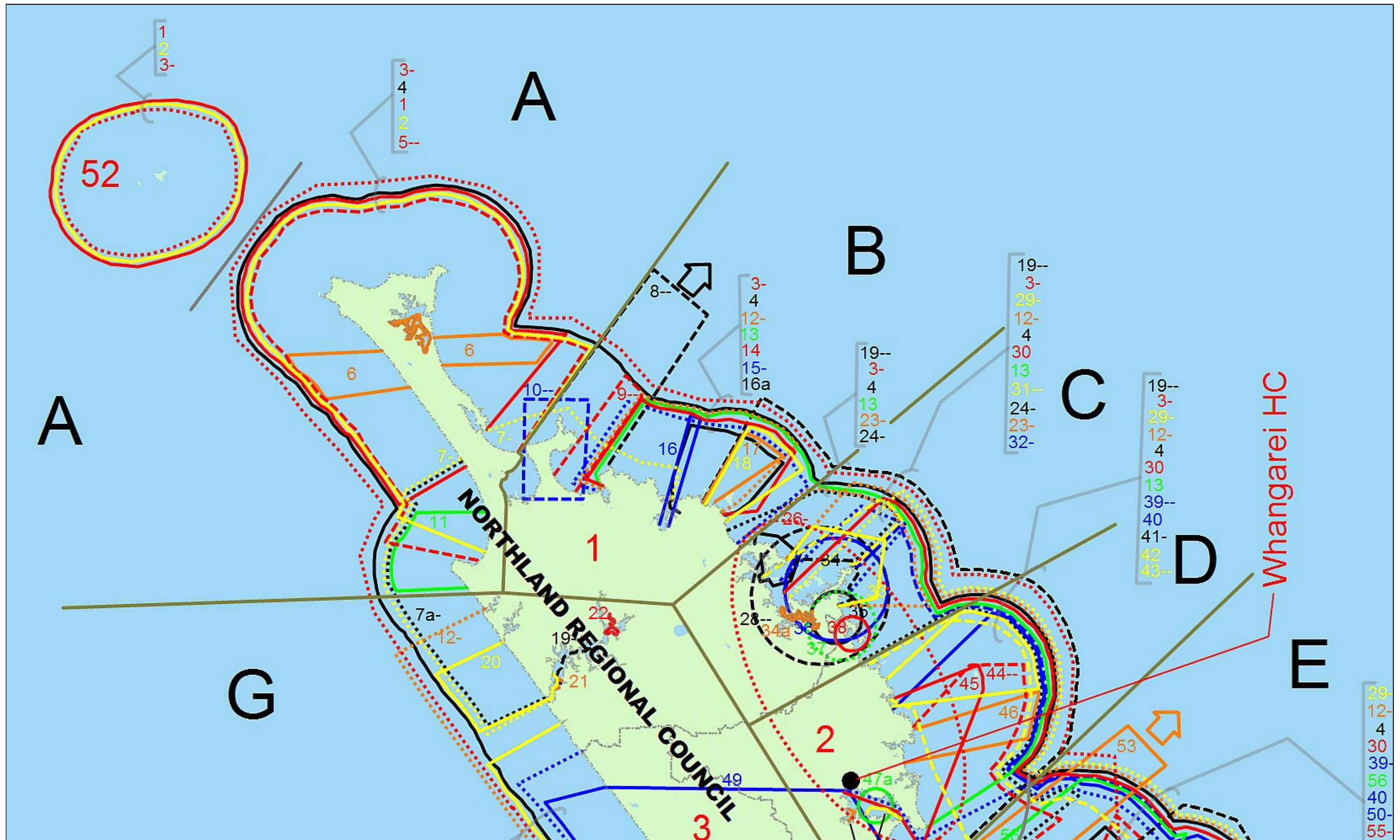

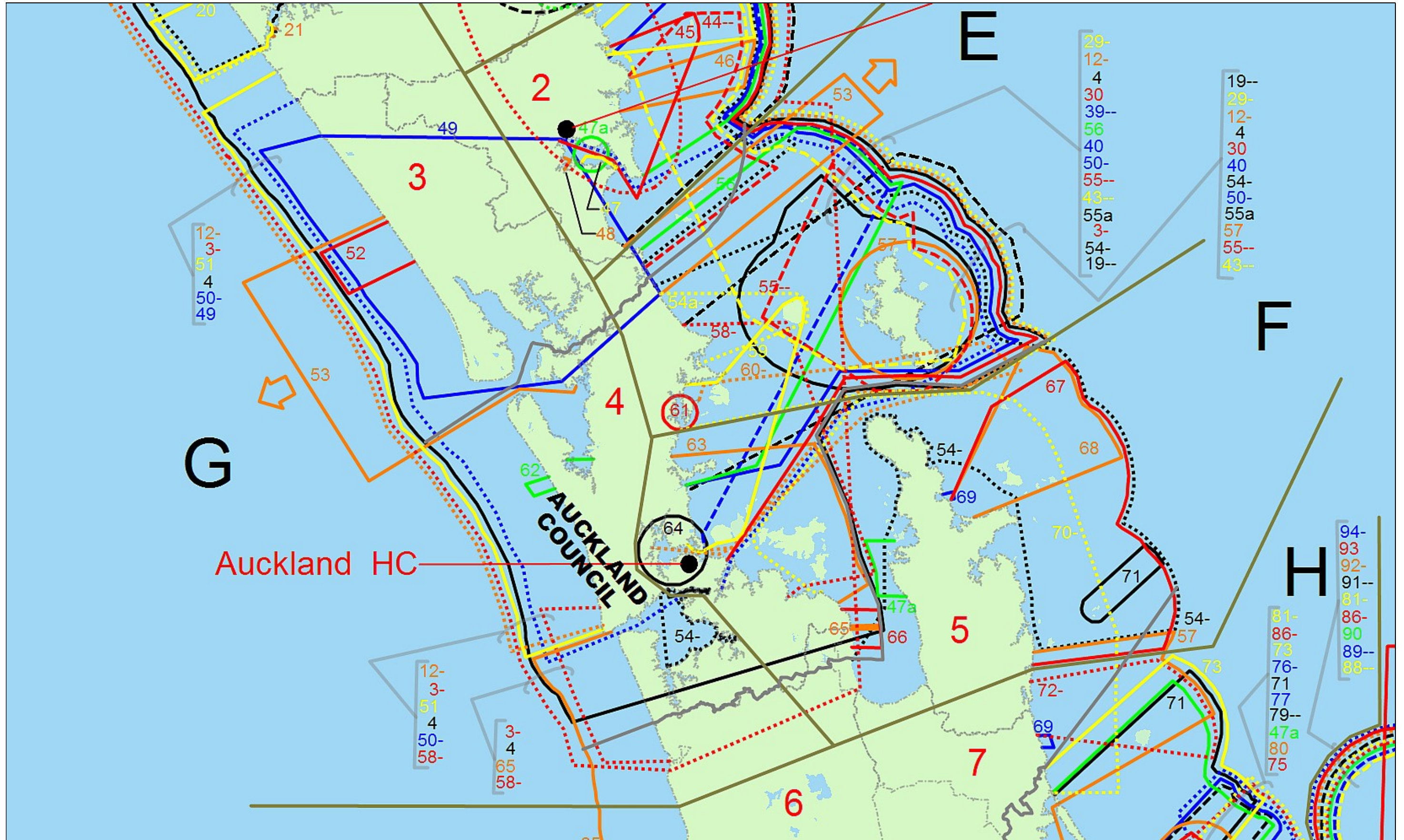

Map 2 – Whangarei to Hauraki

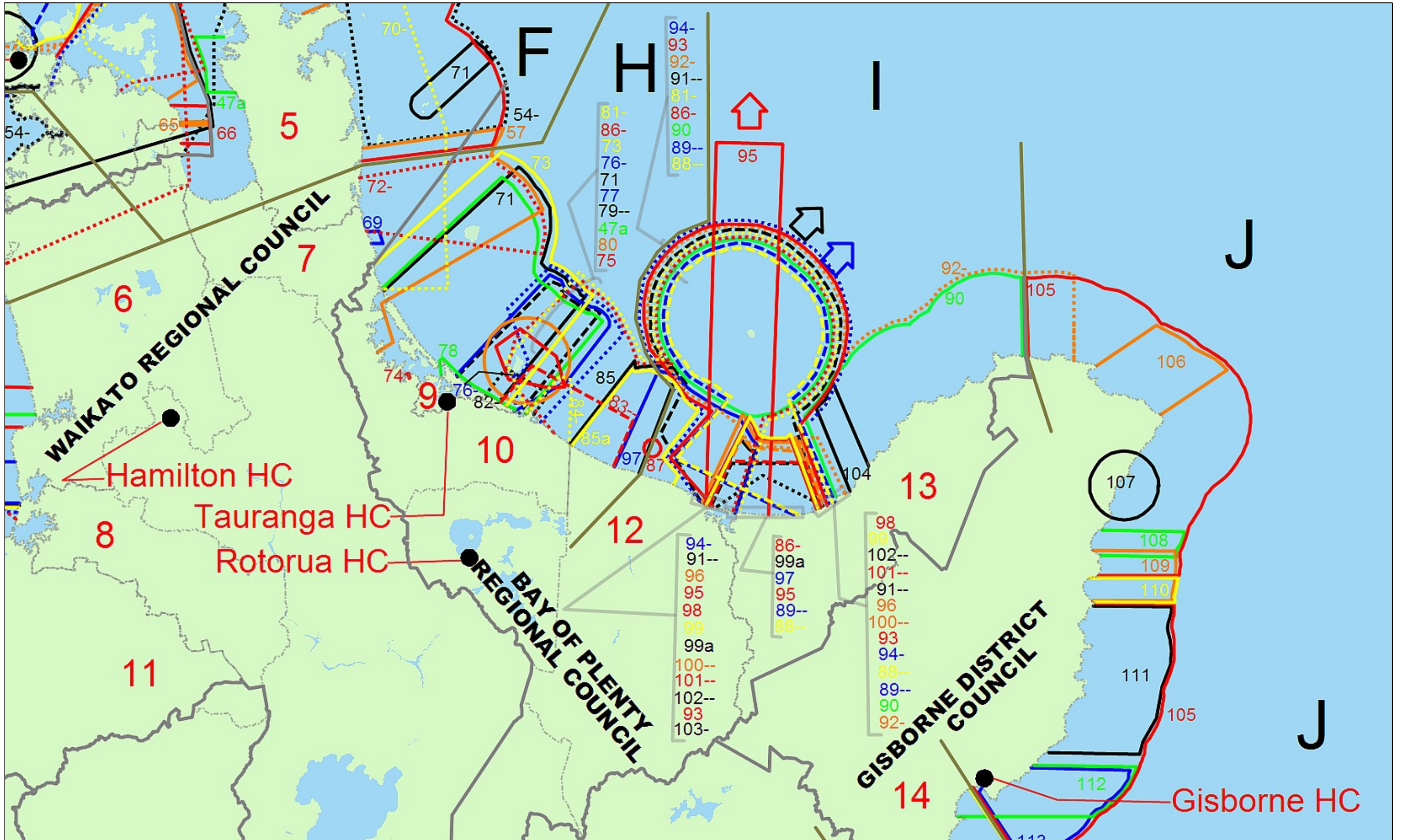

Map 3 – Bay of Plenty to East Coast

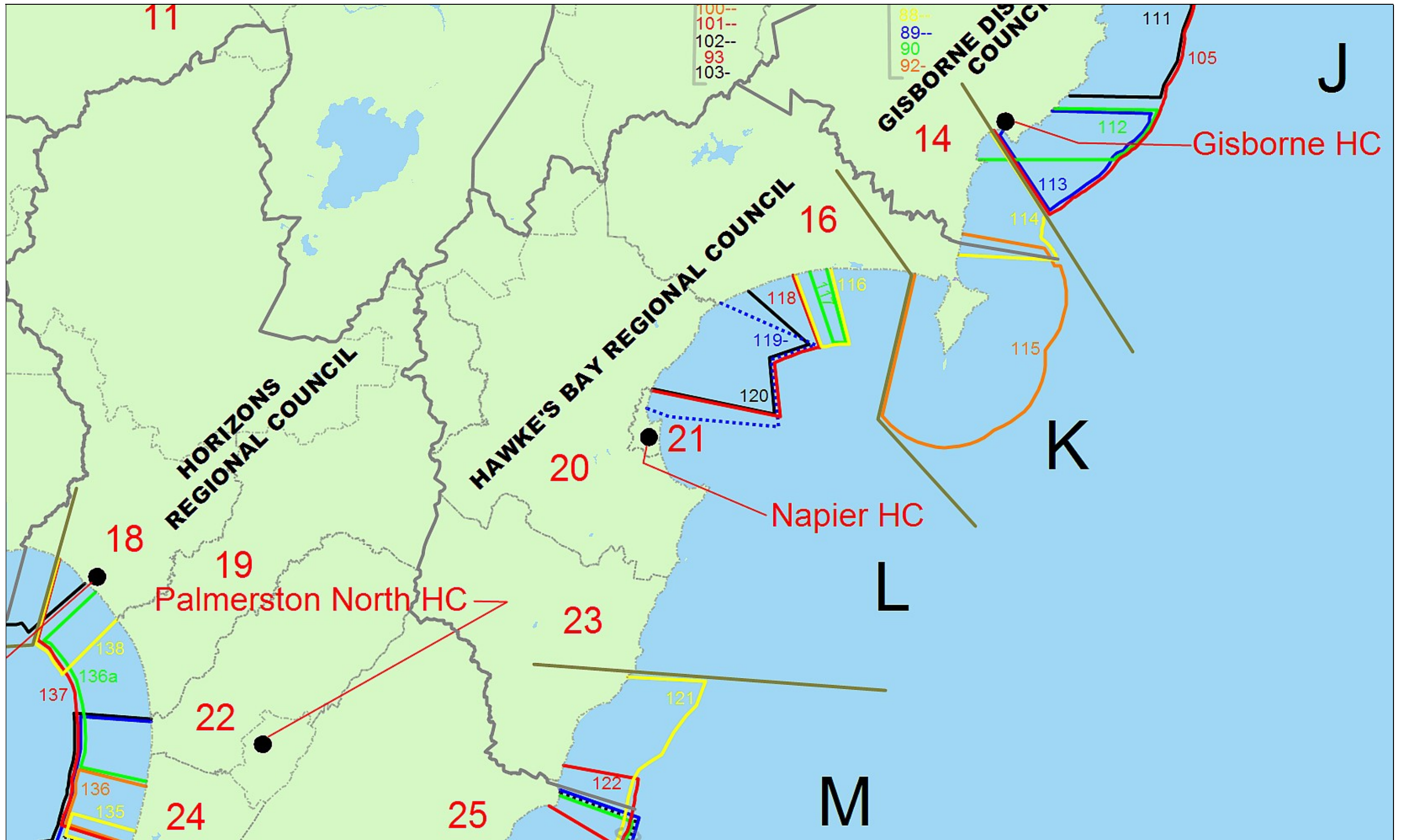

Map 4 – East Coast to Hawke's Bay

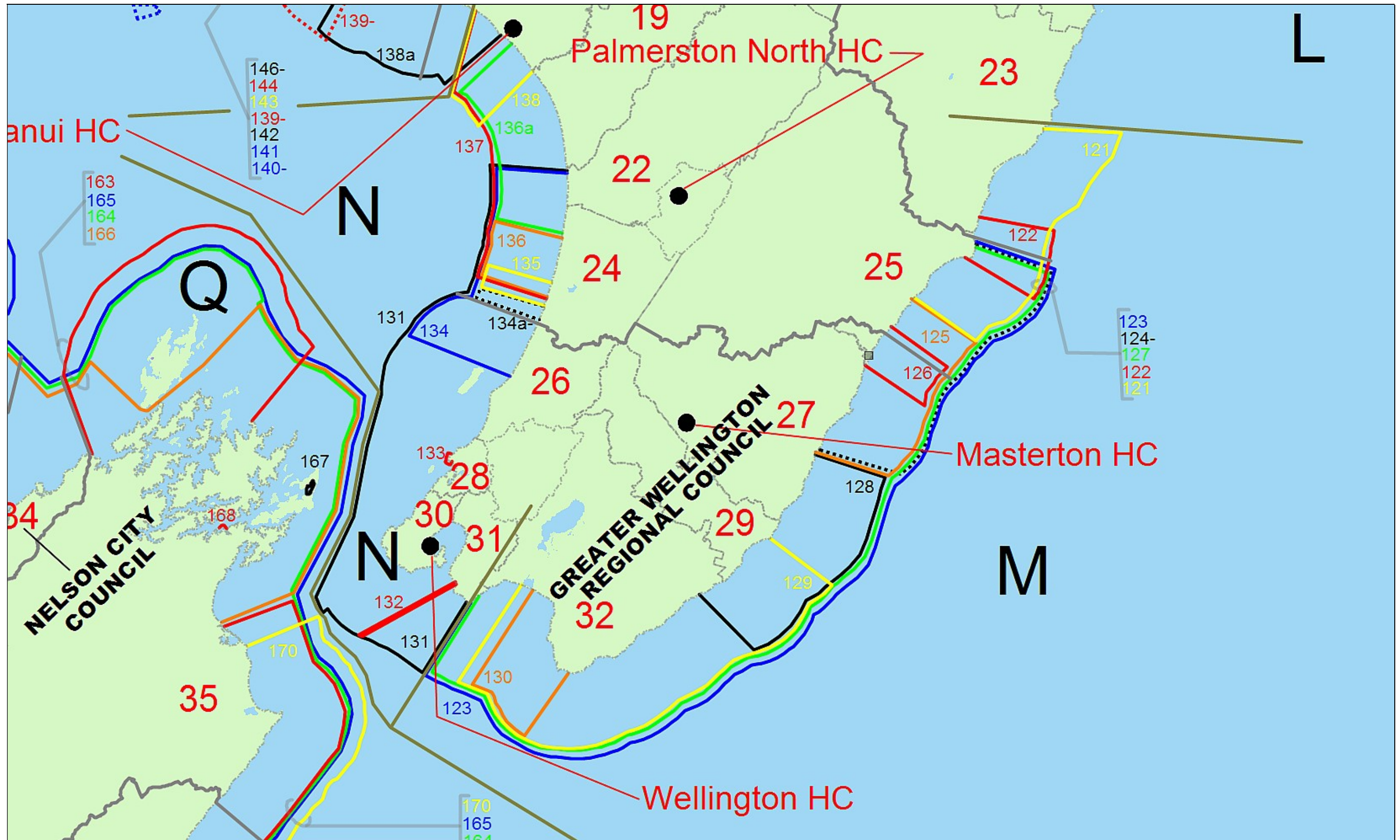

Map 5 – Hawke's Bay to Cook Strait

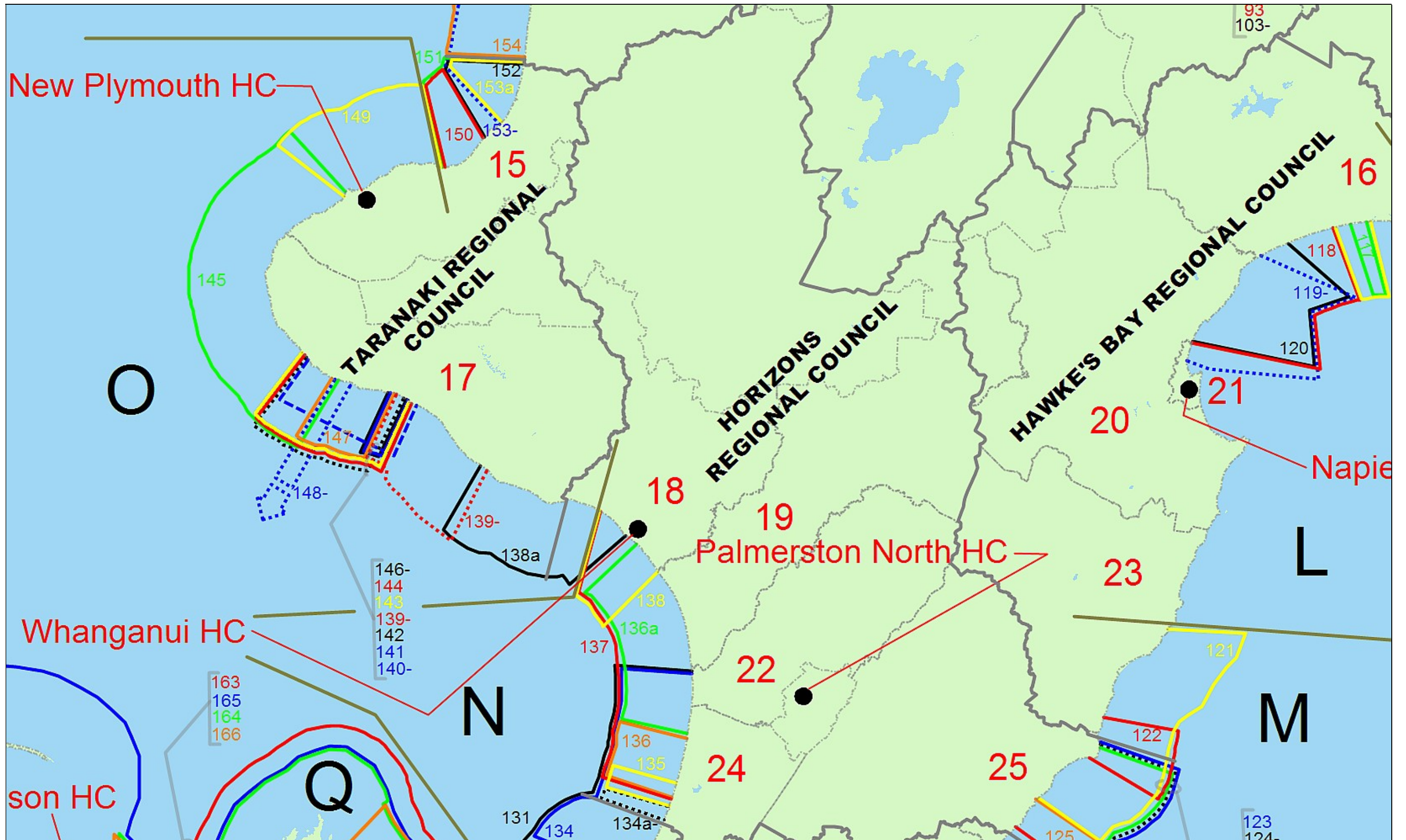

Map 6 – Manawatu to Taranaki

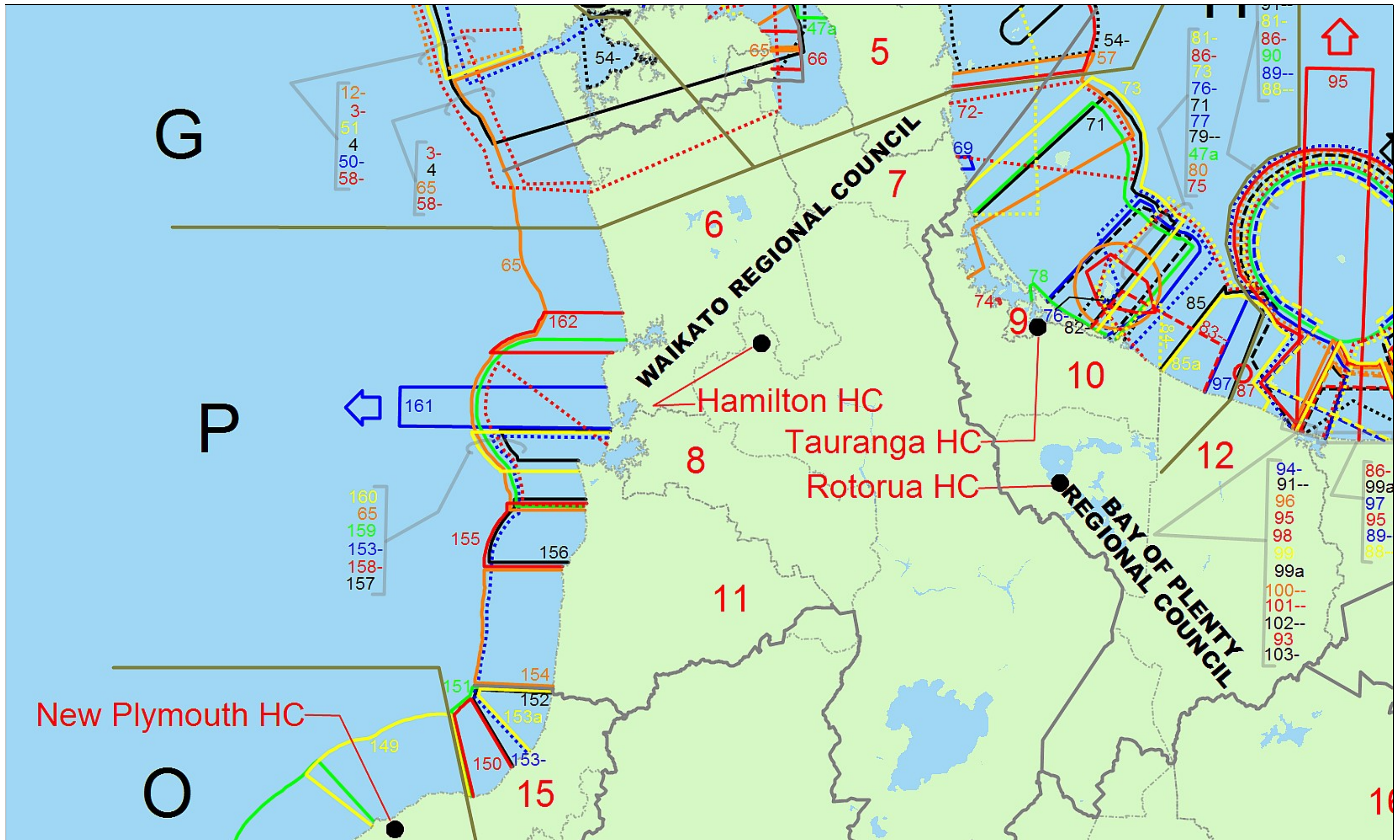

Map 7 – Taranaki to Te Rohe Potae Coast

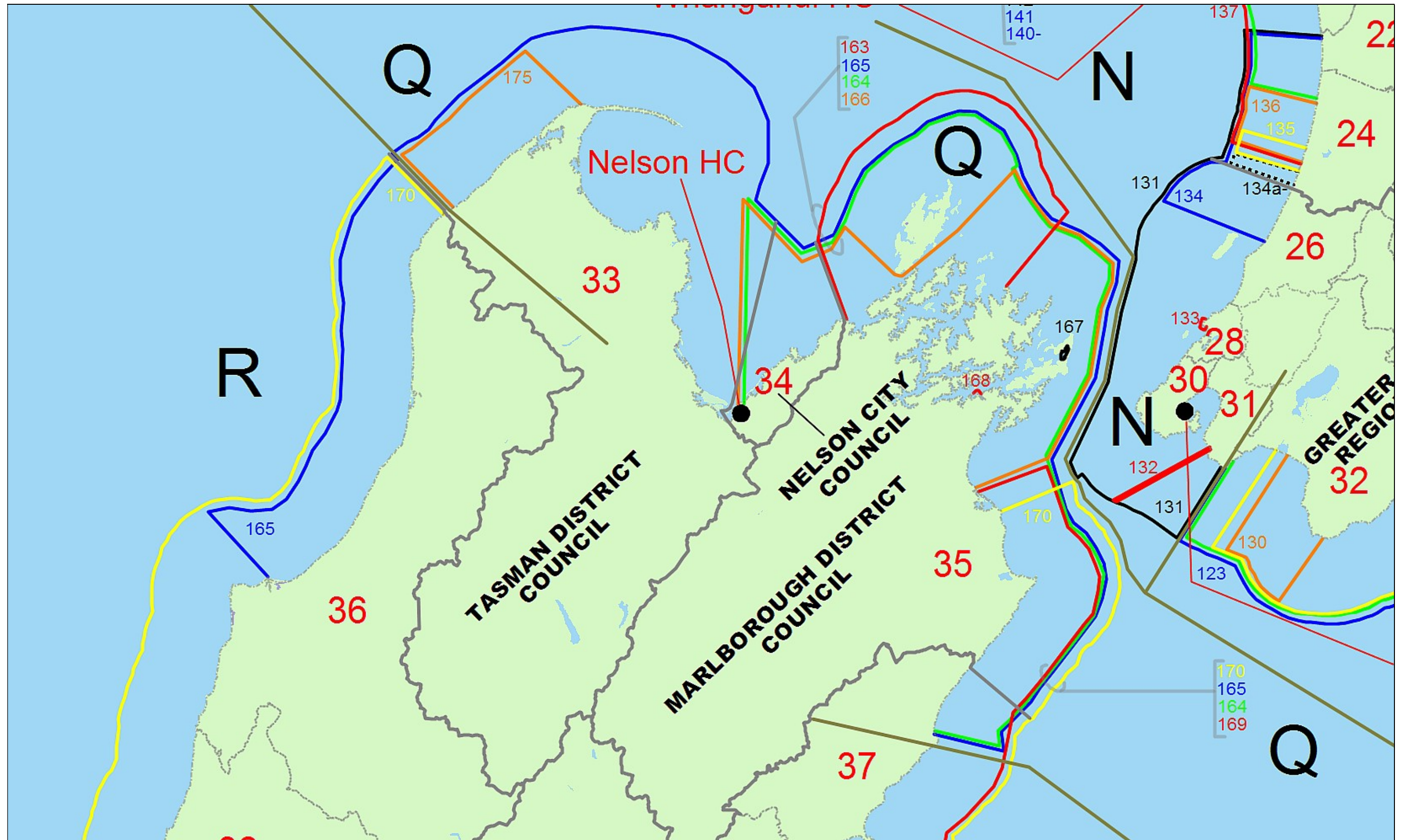

Map 8 – Te Tau Ihu

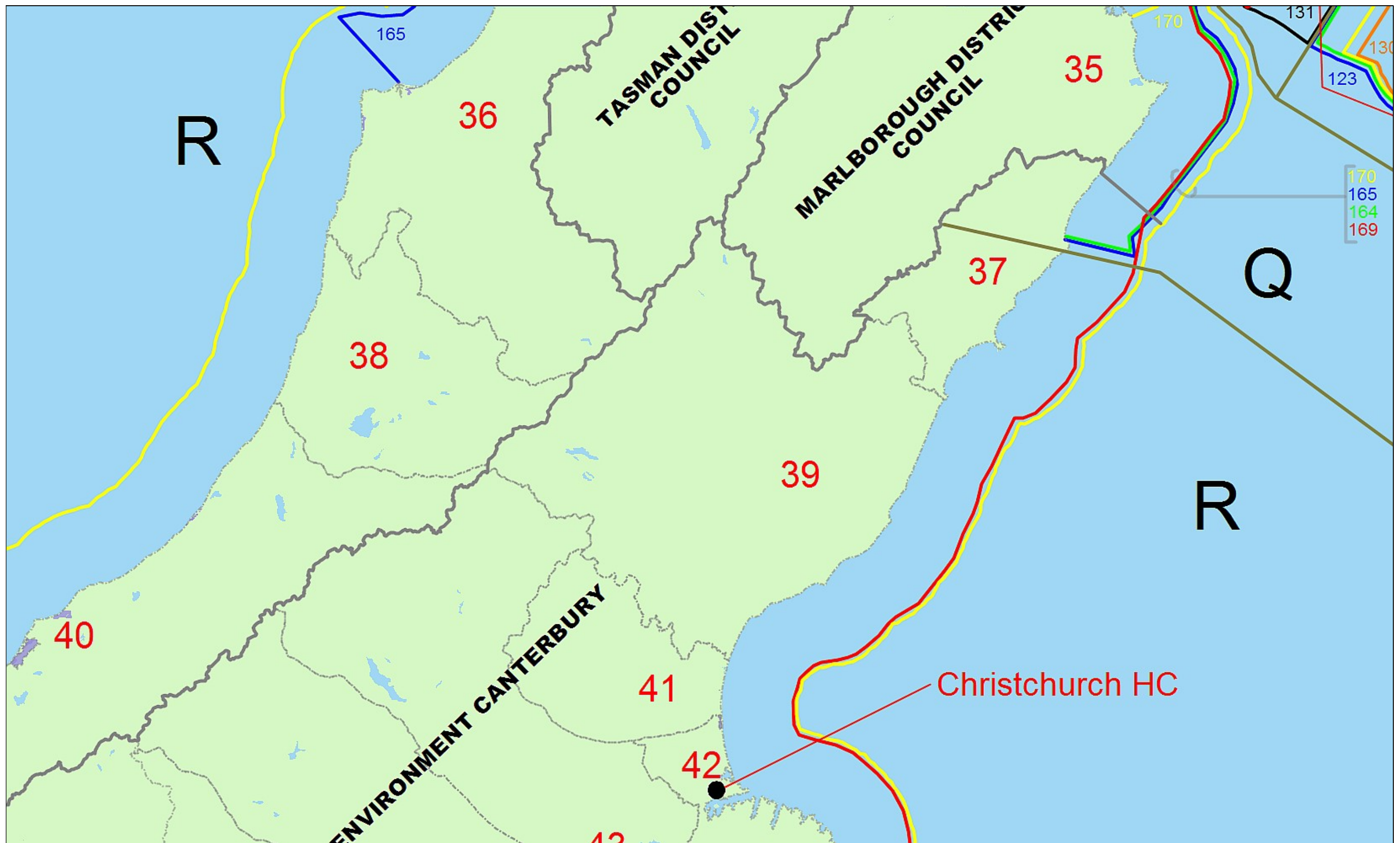

Map 9 – North Canterbury

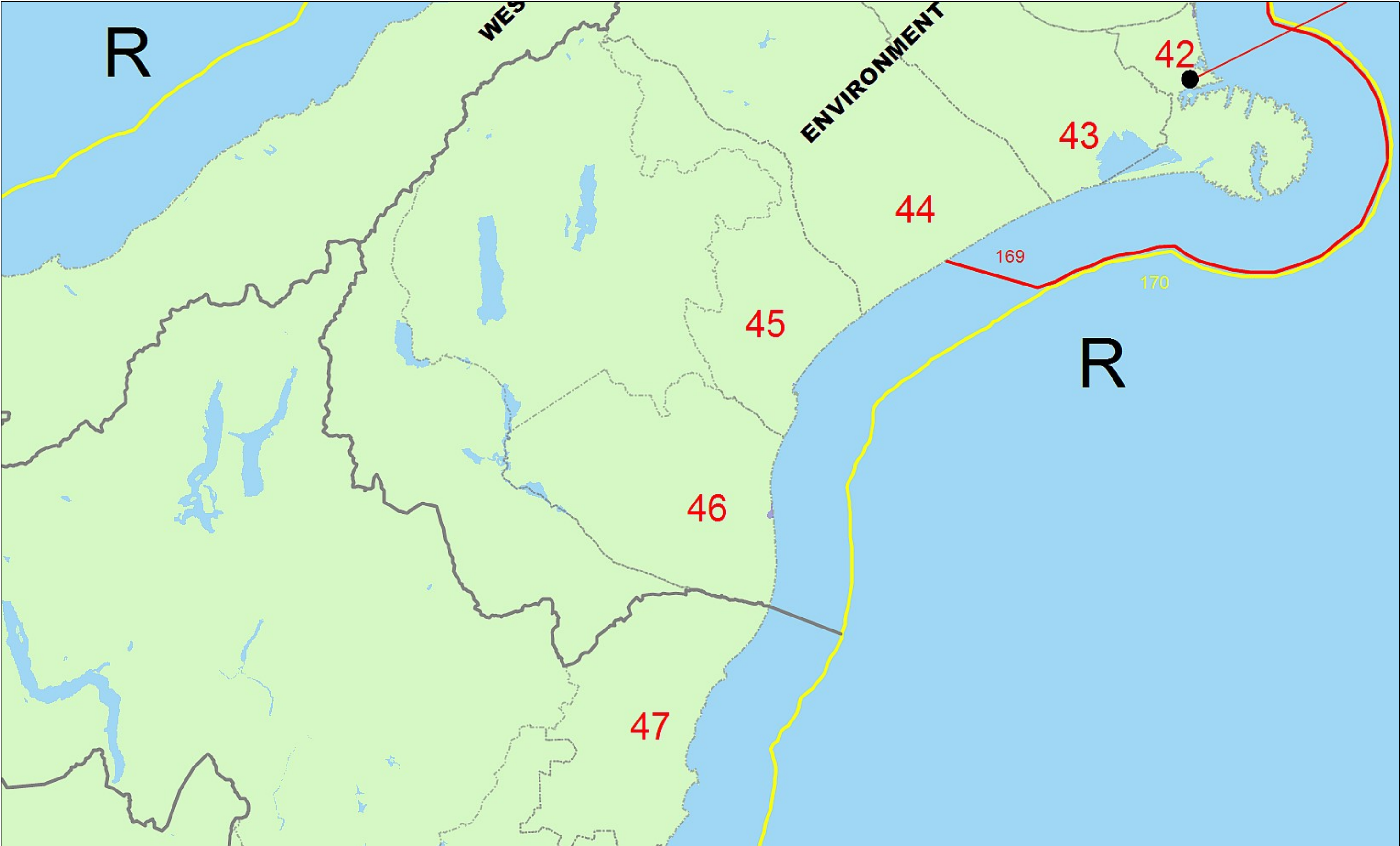

Map 10 – Central Te Waipounamu

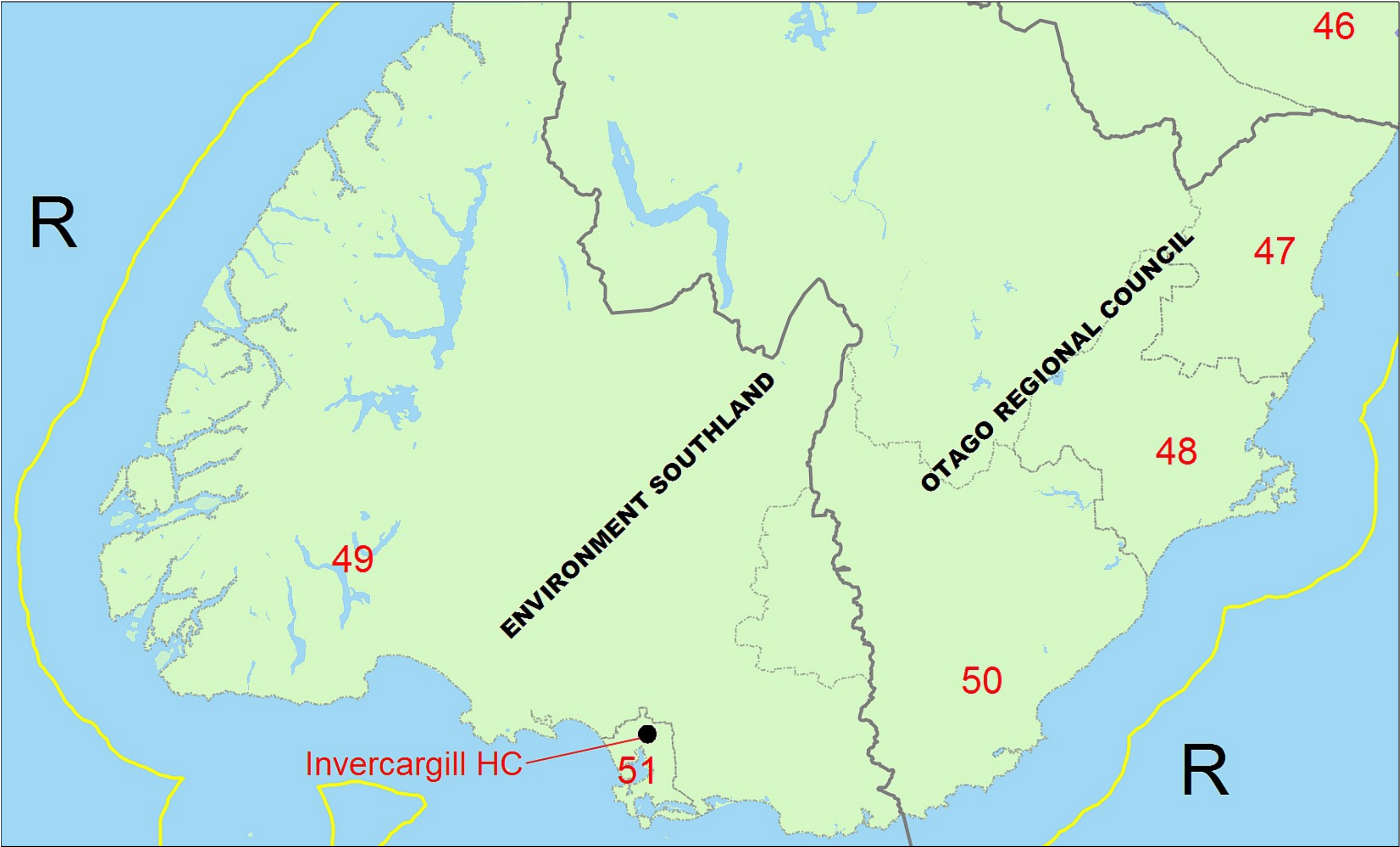

Map 11 – Southern Te Waipounamu

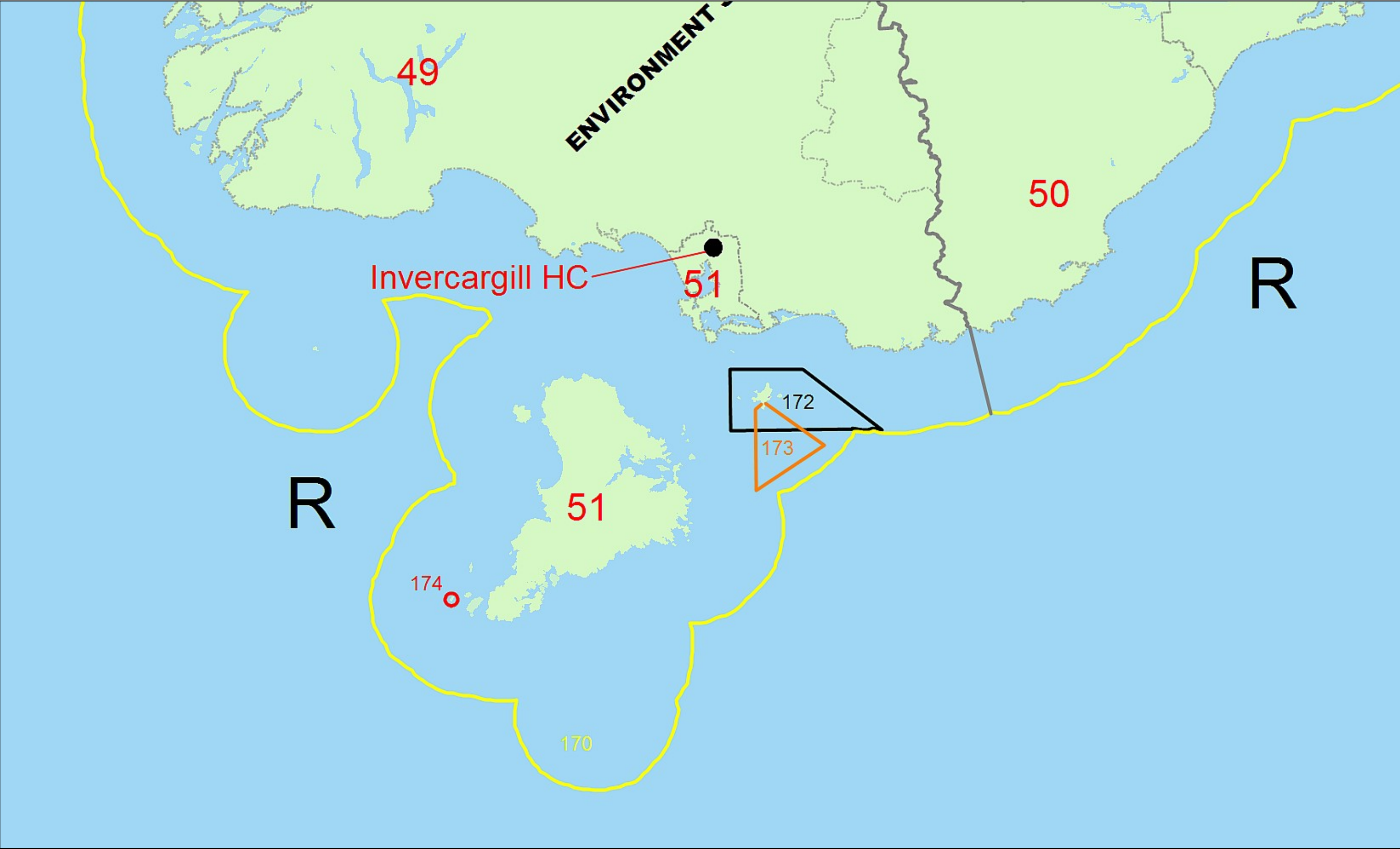
