Review

Promote a system of continuous improvement, including annual reviews of policies and procedures. Implement and develop and review measurable targets.

Hazards and Risks

Ensure all workers and others in the vicinity of the workplace are aware of all hazards and the associated risks, and workers are adequately trained so they can carry out their duties in a safe manner.

Information, Training and Communication

All employees are inducted into the organisation to have an understanding of their health and safety responsibilities and obligations. Encourage Participation

Accurately report, record, investigate, improve work practices and learn from all workplace incidents and discomfort reports.

Develop, implement and regularly practice emergency and evacuation procedures.

Manage Contractors

Consult, cooperate and coordinate with all contractors. Continually assess contractor health, safety and wellbeing through prequalification, audits and observations.
