These maps depict various management units for water quality. These management units apply to surface water only with the exception of the Natural State management unit. The definition of Natural State and Spring-fed in the Glossary of the Plan should be referred to for the detail of the waters included in (and excluded from) these management units. In particular, while the surface water at the eastern end of the Tiwai Peninsula is included within the Natural State management unit, none of the groundwater within the Tiwai groundwater zone is included within the Natural State management unit due to the long term use of groundwater in that zone for the supply of water for industrial purposes.
