Proposed Southland Water and Land Plan – Site Visit

I have referred the various memoranda from counsel regarding the site visit to Judge Borthwick who directs:

The court will attend the Southern Dairy Hub as we consider there would be benefit from viewing what the industry regards as examples of good management practice. We will try to reach the facility Saturday, but emphasise how little time the court has to spend at this Hub and do not know what time we would be on site. We want to see land and herd management rather than the dairy shed. Could you please forward contact details (telephone number and address) to Ms Sprott.

Fish and Game are to provide copies of the maps they refer to in their memo dated 23 July 2019 at 5(a) – my map references do not seem to align.

Fish & Game are to identify on their maps the Queens Reach Nohoanga. The Ngai Tahu aerial may not contain enough detail to identify whilst out on the road.

We will not take Horticulture NZ or the Territorial Authorities up on their suggested site visits.
