The following matters are respectfully put forward on behalf of the Director-General of Conservation Tumuaki Ahurei (the Director-General):

- I seek leave for counsel to be excused from the Environment Court 'all of parties' hearing for the proposed Southland Water and Land Plan appeals on 21 March 2022 only.
- 2. I understand the 'all of parties' hearing commencing on 14 March 2022 may continue into the week of 21 March 2022.

- 6. Should the 'all of parties' hearing continue into 22 March 2022, I will be back in attendance for the Director-General, as I do not expect I will be required to attend the PC8 hearing for longer than a day.
