MINUTE OF THE ENVIRONMENT COURT Resumed hearing (11 July 2023)

Introduction

[1] The purpose of this Minute is to address the supplementary evidence of Dr T Snelder and secondly, the Freshwater Farm Plan Regulations.

Supplementary evidence

[2] Being opposed by Dairy Interests, the court is unable to admit pursuant to s 9 of the Evidence Act 2006, Dr Snelder's supplementary brief of evidence dated

19 June 2023.

[3] For Dr Snelder's evidence to be produced there appear to be two courses. First, the hearing could resume and Dr Snelder, having been sworn and his draft brief confirmed, will be made available for examination. Alternatively, if he is not required for examination by the parties, his evidence could be produced by way of affidavit.

Resource Management (Freshwater Farm Plans) Regulations 2023

- [4] The Regional Council requested that the court not make final directions to amend the proposed plan.
- [5] The court wishes to know the Regional Council's position in relation to final directions being given.

Resumed hearing

[6] Assuming Mr Anderson is instructed to act for Forest & Bird/Fish & Game while Ms Gepp is on sabbatical, the hearing will resume on 9 August 2023. If he is not instructed, then the hearing will be set down for 22 August 2023.

Directions

- [7] I direct that by **Friday 14 July 2023**:
 - (a) Forest & Bird/Fish & Game will confirm whether Mr Anderson is instructed and can appear on 9 August 2023;
 - (b) any party requiring Dr Snelder for cross-examination is to advise the court;
 - (c) if no party requires Dr Snelder for cross-examination, then any party

opposing the production of his evidence by way of affidavit is to advise the court.

[8] Further directions will then issue and the hearing date will be confirmed.
