## MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT:

- Paragraphs [9] [12] of the Court's Minute dated 11 July 2022 directed Mr Wilson to circulate worked examples of the Index of Grazing Pressure he introduced during questioning on 8 July 2022.
- As the Court will be aware, the NES:F has capped the area of IWG to the maximum area of the landholding used for IWG in the 5 year reference period 2014 – 2019.
- I confirm it is not the intent of the relief to enable any increase in area of IWG under Rule 20(a)(i).
- 4. Rather than preparing worked examples of a new metric, Federated Farmers and Wilkins Farming Co Ltd prepared an alternate version of Rule 20(a)(i) which was provided to Council for consideration on 12 July 2022.
- 5. The purpose of this memorandum is twofold:
  - (a) To give advance notice to the Court and parties of the revised version of Rule 20(a)(i) to be put forward by my clients on 27 July 2022; and
  - (b) To request that the direction that Mr Wilson prepare and provide worked examples of the potential new metric be cancelled.
- 6. The revised wording of Rule 20(a)(i) reads as follows:

...does not occur on more than:

- <u>50ha or</u> 15% of the area of the landholding <del>or 100 hectares</del>, whichever is the <del>lesser</del> <u>greater</u> area<u>; and</u>
- <u>the maximum area of the landholding used for intensive</u> <u>winter grazing in the five years 2014 – 2019.</u>
- 7. I respectfully request confirmation from the Court that the worked examples requested from Mr Wilson are not required.
