MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT

This Memorandum of Counsel is filed on behalf of the Southland Regional Council (**Council**) in respect of the appeals against the Council's decision on the proposed Southland Water and Land Plan.

Background

- On 8 February 2022, Counsel filed a Memorandum setting out the parties' positions on the matters addressed in the 10 December 2021 Planning Joint Witness Statement (**10 December JWS**). This Memorandum indicated, for a number of provisions, that all interested parties agreed with the outcome for provisions set out in the 10 December JWS.
- In the Record of Pre-Hearing Conference dated 15 February 2022, the Court directed that, if the planners rely on technical expert evidence to inform the agreed amendments to the provisions, further evidence is required from those technical experts.¹
- 4 On 18 February 2022, Counsel filed a Memorandum identifying the technical witnesses the planners relied on to inform the agreed provisions.

Dr Monaghan's attendance at the all of parties hearing

- One of the technical experts identified in the 18 February 2022 Memorandum was Dr Ross Monaghan.
- Dr Monaghan's expertise was considered necessary to support matters relating to critical source area management, setbacks, and intensive winter grazing. In particular, his expertise was relevant to the (then) agreed Policy 16.²
- Since the 18 February Memorandum was filed, parties have filed their rebuttal evidence and memoranda setting out the final relief they seek. It is now apparent, on the basis of that evidence and those memoranda, that the provisions where full agreement has been reached has narrowed. Counsel filed a Memorandum on 7 March 2022 which set out

Policy 16 was identified in the Memorandum dated 8 February 2022 as being agreed as between the parties.

- at Appendix A the limited matters on which parties are still agreed and which are to be considered at the all of parties hearing.
- Dr Monaghan's evidence and expertise is not relevant to the matters set out in Appendix A to the 7 March Memorandum. On the basis that his evidence will not be of use to the Court in the all of parties hearing, Counsel seeks leave for Dr Monaghan to be excused from attending the all of parties hearing.
- 9 For the avoidance of doubt, Counsel confirms that Dr Monaghan will be called by the Council to give evidence in relation to the matters which remain in dispute during the disputed provisions hearing.
