Background

- Southwood Export Limited and Others has filed an appeal on two provisions of the Proposed Southland Water and Land Plan.
- Discussions have been continuing between the parties as to whether it is possible to resolve these appeal points without a hearing being necessary.
- This memorandum responds to the Court's directions to all parties to identify and exchange a memorandum identifying the relief being sought.
- The relief sought is the same as described in the Notice of Appeal, and advice as to the tracked change relief was provided to the Regional Council on the 29th of October 2021.

Relief Sought

5 Southwood Export Limited and Others seeks the following relief:

Rule 25

Amend Rule 25(a)(iv) by adding the underlined text:

"Cultivation <u>(excluding aerial herbicide spraying for forestry purposes)</u> does not occur on land with a slope greater than 20 degrees."

Definition – Cultivation

Amend the definition of "Cultivation" by adding the underlined text and deleting the text shown as struck through:

"Cultivation

Preparing land for growing pasture or a crop by mechanical tillage (excluding stick raking), direct drilling, herbicide spraying, or, herbicide spraying followed by over-sowing for pasture or forage crops ('colloquially referred to as spray and pray'), but excluding any spraying undertaken solely for the control of pest plant species."
