 - (b) Increase the cultivation setback distances from waterways based on the slope of the land at;

Relief sought

- 9 Rayonier opposes the relief sought by Forest and Bird's appeal on the grounds that the proposed changes:
 - (a) Do not promote the sustainable management of natural and physical resources in accordance with section 5 and other relevant matters at sections 6 and 7 of the RMA;
 - (b) Are not supported by an adequate cost/benefit analysis required by section 34 of the RMA;
 - (c) Are inconsistent with the National Environmental Standards for Plantation Forestry;
 - (d) Would place undue regulatory burden on plantation forestry activities without achieving any corresponding environmental benefit
