Hi Stephen –

Following on from our meeting last week, there were a couple of points that I'd like to respond to / confirm with you, as per:

1. Dye Test Discharge Permit:

Thanks for raising this. We can confirm that the ICC would like to include application for future dye testing using non-toxic dye as discussed at our meeting on the 11th.

2. Stormwater Bylaw:

As Malcom advised at our meeting, the ICC does not have a specific bylaw relating to stormwater management and discharges, however addresses stormwater management through their Invercargill City Council Bylaw 2016/1 - Code of Practice for Land Development and Subdivision Infrastructure and Bylaw 2007/1 – Trade Waste, and sites storing or using hazardous substances are subject to the national HASNO regulations but no specific local controls.

3. LTP Consultation:

You had requested the actual numbers of responses for the consultation undertaken as part of the LTP on the stormwater renewal, rather than only the percentages as given in the application. The following table gives the number of responses for each option.

	Option 1 - Retain current expenditure	Option 2 -The Council's Preferred option: Increase to 1% by 2021	Option 3: Increase to 1.5% by 2021
Stormwater	12	41	9
Sewage	11	36	14

4. Regional Plan policies:

You indicated you had some concerns regarding the evaluation of the activity in the context of regional policies. We acknowledge that, and expect to review and address the policies in due course.

5. Application to discharge to the CMA:

We acknowledge that the current application does not address discharges to the CMA. As discussed, we are reviewing the requirements with ICC and will advise the approach shortly.
