***Hearing of Consent Application APP-20168843, Invercargill City Council***

Regarding the above application to discharge water and contaminants into surface water bodies from reticulated stormwater systems, I would like to inform you that a hearing by a panel of Commissioners is to be held at 9am on Wednesday 9 August 2017, at the Kelvin Hotel, 20-22 Kelvin Street, Invercargill.

The following dates and deadlines, as per Section 103B of the RMA apply to this hearing:

- Circulation of the s42A Hearing Report and any Council evidence. **18 July 2017**
- Circulation of the Applicant's evidence **25 July 2017**
- Circulation of Submitters' expert evidence **1 August 2017**
- Hearing date **9-11 August 2017**

A copy of the Council's s42A report and the associated appendices are attached. The Council will make the applicant's evidence available to all parties once it is received. **You must submit your evidence to Council in advance of the specified date to allow for circulation within timeframes<sup>1</sup>.**

All submitters have been invited to attend, but only those requesting the right to be heard have speaking rights.

Costs incurred on your application, excluding any deposit paid, are currently in the order of \$26,388.76.

Council's standard deposit for hearings is \$5,000 per day or part thereof. The charges must be paid before the application goes to hearing. **As such, I now request a further payment, of \$15,000, to continue processing your application.<sup>2</sup>**

<sup>2</sup> As per Council's Long Term Plan where the charge is inadequate to recover the Council's reasonable and actual costs, under Section 36(3) it may also require an additional charge to be paid.

**If the deposit is not paid by 1 August 2017** then the hearing will be postponed, at the applicant's expense. The processing of the application will remain on hold under Section 36(7) of the Resource Management Act until this payment has been received by Council. Further information about consent processing fees can be found in the attached schedule of fees.
