**MINUTE OF HEARING COMMISSIONERS  
REGARDING EXTENSION OF TIME TO IDENTIFY SCOPE ISSUES**

---

- 1 On 2 August Commissioner Enright and I issued a minute directing that:
  - a. The applicant circulates a summary of the additional mitigation measures proposed, along with all Overseer modelling, and provides access for auditing of the new modelling, as soon as practical but no later than 5 August;
  - b. Any party may advise of issues with the scope of the amended applications by 7 August;
  - c. The applicant and Council meet at the earliest opportunity at a time acceptable to both parties, to allow any necessary clarification of the amendments and agree on acceptable timeframe for the hearings and circulation of evidence.
  
- 2 Mr Erceg, Council Consents Officer, has requested an extension of time to advise on any issues of scope until 5pm Monday 12 August. This is due to the absence of Ms Grant this week.
  
- 3 We have no objection to the extension of time to identify scope issues until Monday 12 August.
  
- 4 We also understand that a meeting has been arranged between parties for this Friday, 9 August, in accordance with direction (c) above. It is important that a timeframe for the hearing to proceed is finalised without further delay. We note that we are still working towards a possible hearing date of 16 September. If this date is not suitable, parties should advise Ms Bragg of the agreed, preferred date following the meeting on Friday. If no agreement can be reached, we will determine a date at that time. If process issues cannot be resolved pragmatically, then we may convene a teleconference. The applicant (and other parties) should indicate if that is a preferred way forward.
