Thank you for applying for resource consent on behalf of **Blue Sky Meats NZ Ltd.** to undertake numerous activities associated with operations at the Meat Works in Morton Mains.

The application has been formally received. However, I will need an application for further consent from you before your application can progress.

This email outlines the additional consent application I am requesting, the reasons for the request, your options and how they affect you. **Please read the points below carefully.**

I have reviewed the application and consider that an application for the ongoing use of the non-agricultural effluent storage facilities being the three ponds associated with the wastewater treatment plant as outlined in the application is necessary under Section 91 of the Resource Management Act 1991 and in accordance with the following rule.

- Rule 32(c) – Construction, maintenance, and use of new non-agricultural effluent storage facilities – being the three ponds associated with the wastewater treatment plant as outlined in the application

I consider it is reasonable to postpone the processing of the current application until the additional application has been made. Please note that an application will only be considered to have been made if it is complete under S88 of the Resource Management Act 1991. Incomplete applications will be sent back in accordance with S88(3), and the existing application will remain on hold under S91.

Decisions on the application will be postponed until you lodge the additional application for the further activities **or provide satisfactory reasoning as to why consent for the activity is not required.**

The time taken between this email and our receipt of the additional applications under S91 will not be included in our total processing timeframes for this application.
