This is a submission on an application from: Southland District Council – APP 20232970 for a resource consent to discharge treated wastewater from the Edendale-Wyndham wastewater treatment plant into the Mataura River at the Edendale-Wyndham Road bridge at or about NZTM 2000 1278920E 4861696N.

We are not a trade competitor for the purposes of <u>section 308B</u> of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The specific parts of the application that our submission relates to are: the entire application.

Our submission is:

Hokonui Rūnanga Inc **opposes** the application.

The reasons for opposing the application are as follows:

- 1. The proposed activity does not align with the cultural significance of the Mataura River and proposals to restore the mauri of the Matuara River.
- 2. The proposal does not address the adverse effects on mana whenua of the direct discharge of contaminants, including treated wastewater, into the awa.
- 3. The AEE is inadequate. The AEE is based on the premise that the effects of this discharge will be the same as the current discharge and therefore are appropriate, even though the volumes proposed to be discharged are considerably larger and the planning framework within which these matters are considered under the Resource Management Act 1991 (the Act) has changed.

- 4. The proposed activity fails to achieve the purpose of the Act; to manage freshwater in accordance with the fundamental concept of te mana o te wai as required under the National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management 2020; and is inconsistent with the Southland Regional Policy Statement and the proposed Southland Land and Water Regional Plan.
- 5. We do not agree that the activity meets the threshold to enable it to be granted as a non-complying activity under s104D of the Act.
- 6. The application relies on s124 of the Act but the application is not for the same activity as the existing consent. The proposed volume of wastewater to be discharged in this application is considerably larger than the current consent. Therefore, in our view, it is not an application for the same activity as the existing consent and s124 of the Act does not apply.
- 7. While the application is for a short-term duration, there is no proposal for alternative discharge options being investigated by Southland District Council. The current consent duration was for 15 years during which time the Council has been aware of the position of mana whenua on the discharge of contaminants into the awa, yet no progress has been made towards addressing this issue. We are concerned granting this consent as applied for will simply enable a cycle of granting discharge permits with short durations to Southland District Council, to allow the wastewater to continue to be disposed of into the awa, while little or no progress is made towards an alternative.

We seek the following decision from the consent authority:

To decline the resource consent application; or

To impose conditions requiring the applicant to begin immediate work in consultation with Hokonui Rūnanga Inc or their mandated delegate (and other representatives of mana whenua) on options to remove the discharge from the awa by the end of the proposed five-year consent duration.

We wish to be heard in support of our submission.

If others make a similar submission, we will consider presenting a joint case with them at the hearing.


